ORDER:

While moving the Demand No.19, Health and Family Welfare Department for the year 2013-14, Hon'ble Minister for Health has announced on the floor of the Assembly that 20 Primary Health Centres will be upgraded as 30 bedded Primary Health Centres.

2. The Mission Director, State Health Society in his letter first read above has sent necessary proposals for the upgradation of 63 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) as 30 bedded Primary Health Centres under National Rural Health Mission funds. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in his letter second read above has sent necessary proposal for the upgradation of one Primary Health Centre at Karisalpatti in Cheranmadevi Block, Tirunelveli District as 30 bedded Primary Health Centre from state fund.

3. Based on approved staff pattern, the Medical Officer and Para Medical staff need to be appointed on time scale of pay and Multipurpose Hospital Worker be appointed on contractual basis on consolidated pay. The following additional posts are required for the upgradation of each Primary Health Centre as 30 bedded Primary Health Centre:

The Mission Director, State Health Society has requested the Government Orders for upgradation of 63 Primary Health Centres as 30 bedded Hospital utilising National Rural Health Mission funds and for the upgradation of one Primary Health Centre at Karisalpatti in Cheranmadevi Block, Tirunelveli District under state fund.

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposals of the Mission Director, State Health Society and the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and decided to accept the proposals. They accordingly issue the following orders:

- i. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to upgrade 63 Primary Health Centres indicated in the Annexure to this order as 30 bedded Primary Health Centres under National Rural Health Mission funds at a total cost of Rs.76.13 crores.
- ii. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to upgrade One Primary Health Centre at Karisalpatti in Cheranmadevi Block, Tirunelveli District from state fund at a cost of Rs.1.208 crore.
- iii. The following posts are sanctioned in time scale of pay to each of the 64 upgraded Primary Health Centres and the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is permitted to fill up these posts through the Medical Services Recruitment Board / Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and the Employment exchange:

The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine / Chief Engineer (Buildings) is directed to send application in the prescribed format along with the copy of this order to Finance (BG.I) Department for sanction of advance for required quantum. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine / Chief Engineer (Buildings) is also directed to send necessary explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2013-14 to obtain approval of the Legislative Assembly at the appropriate stage.
