#### ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister, Government of Tamil Nadu, among others, has made the following announcement on the floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly under Rule 110 on 05.07.2017 that "Four Maternal and Child Health Centres of Excellence will be established at a cost of Rs.20 crores each in Mayiladuthurai, Dindigul, Krishnagiri and Thiruvallur District Headquarter Hospitals at a total cost of Rs.80 crore.

- 2. The Hon'ble Minister (Health and Family Welfare) among others has made the following announcement on the floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year 2017-18, that "Additional building to 7 District Headquarters Hospital at Mettur Dam, Kallakurichi, Perambalur, Kulithalai, Thenkasi, Walaja, Pollachi and 2 Sub-Districts Hospital at Athur and Thirupathur (Vellore District) will be constructed at a cost of Rs.43.50 crore.
- 3. The Mission Director, State Health Society, in the letter second read above, has stated that the proposals for various civil works, required had been included in Supplementary Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) 2016-17 and Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) 2017 -18, for Strengthening of First Referral Units (FRUs), in order to increase the service delivery of the institutions to cope with the increased patient load of the institutions. The National Programme for Co-ordination Committee (NPCC) of Government of India approved the proposals for a total cost of Rs.14,370 lakhs, for various civil works for strengthening of First Referral Units (FRUs), under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) with a budgetary provisions of Rs.1,380 lakh in Supplementary Record of Proceedings 2016-17 and Rs.2,323 lakh in Record of Proceedings 2017-18.

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4. The Mission Director, State Health Society has stated that the amount of Rs.1220 lakh approved for construction of Out Patient Block for Government Hospital Pattukottai and Government Hospital Orthanadu in Thanjavur under National Health Mission had been reallocated to the following works based on the necessity:-

In this regard, detailed agendas No.13 and 61 had been placed in the 32<sup>nd</sup> Executive Committee Meeting held on 10.03.2017 and 33<sup>rd</sup> Executive Committee Meeting held on 23.06.2017 respectively, seeking permission for reallocation of funds on priority basis and release of funds to Public Works Department and Director of Medical and Rural Health Services as the case may be, except the reallocation of fund to Government Hospital, Dhenkanikottai.

- 5. As per the directions issued in G.O.(Ms).No.116, Health and Family Welfare (EAP-II-2) Department dated 25.3.2011, the fund approved for civil works under National Health Mission have to be remitted into Government of Tamil Nadu account, under Receipt Head of Accounts and the funds are to be sanctioned for execution of civil works through Public Works Department. However the Mission Director, National Health Mission has sent copy of the challan for an amount Rs.6,08,00,000/- (Rupees Six crore and eight lakh only).
- 6. The Mission Director, State Health Society has requested Government Order in this regard.
- 7. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of Mission Director, State Health Society and accordingly issue the following orders:
  - i. Administrative Sanction is accorded for strengthening of First Referral Units (FRUs) as detailed below at a total cost of Rs.143,70,00,000/-(Rupees One hundred and forty three crore and seventy lakh only).

The strengthening of District Hospitals Maternity and Child Health wings in 4 Hospital, Special New Born Care Units (SNCUs) in 4 Hospitals, Operation Theatre in Comprehensive Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care (CEmONC) Centers are detailed in the Annexure to this Order

ii. Financial sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.6.08 crore (Rupees Six crore and eight lakh only) for the works mentioned in para 7(i) above in respect of strengthening of First Referral Units (FRUs) through Public Works Department.

- iii. The Engineer- in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai is permitted to issue orders to the Executive Engineers of the concerned divisions for drawal of funds
- iv. The Mission Director shall be permitted to remit the balance of funds required for the works as and when it is approved by Government of India, as per Government Order first read into the following head of account:-

0210-Rural Health Services 800- other Receipts- AD-Receipts from Government of India. (DPC 0210-02-800-AD)

8. The amount sanctioned in para 7(ii) prepage shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4211-00 Capital outlay on Family Welfare - 103 Maternity and Child Health - Central sector schemes - SA National Component-Reproductive and Health Project - 16 - Major works" (DPC-4211-00-103-SA1608).

- 9. Necessary funds have been provided in Revised Estimate 2017-18. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) / Engineer in Chief (Buildings), Public Works Department is authorized to draw the amount.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of finance department vide its U.O.No.10384/Health-I/18, dated: 12.03.2018.
