#### ORDER:-

In the reference first read above, the State Planning Commission has, among others, recommended for establishment of Clinical Simulation Skill Labs in Six Government Medical Colleges at Tiruchirappalli, Chengalpattu, Salem, Thanjavur, Madurai and Tirunelveli and One Government District Head Quarters Hospital, Cuddalore at a cost of Rs.10.85 crore for funding of innovative schemes under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) (Round – II) for the year 2017 - 2018.

2. Based on the above recommendation, in the reference second read above, the Mission Director, State Health Society has forwarded a proposal and requested the Government to accord administrative and financial sanction for establishment of Clinical Simulation Skill Labs in Six Government Medical Colleges at Tiruchirappalli, Chengalpattu, Salem, Thanjavur, Madurai and Tirunelveli and One Government District Head Quarters Hospital, Cuddalore at a cost of Rs.10.85 crore for procurement of equipment and to recruit Man Power on outsourcing basis for one year through 108 Ambulance Service Provider, under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) (Round – II) for the year 2017 - 2018. The Standing Finance Committee has also approved funding of Rs.10.85 crore in the year 2017-2018 for the above project.

- 3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Mission Director, State Health Society, accord
  - i) permission to the Mission Director, State Health Society to establish Clinical Simulation Skill Labs in Six Government Medical College Hospitals at Tiruchirappalli, Chengalpattu, Salem, Thanjavur, Madurai and Tirunelveli and One Government District Head Quarters Hospital at Cuddalore under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) (Round-II) for the year 2017 2018 under State Innovation Fund;
  - ii) administrative and financial sanction for the establishment of Clinical Simulation Skill Labs in Six Government Medical College Hospitals at Tiruchirappalli, Chengalpattu, Salem, Thanjavur, Madurai and Tirunelveli and One Government District Head Quarters Hospital, Cuddalore at a total cost of Rs.10.85 crore as below:
    - a) for procurement of equipment for Clinical Simulation Skill Labs in the above six Government Medical College Hospitals and One Government District Head Quarters Hospital at a cost of Rs.8.75 crore through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited (i.e. Rs.1.25 crore per centre) as detailed below:-

Further, the amount sanctioned towards purchase of equipment shall not be paid in cash, but shall be credited to the following Personal Deposit Account of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai:
