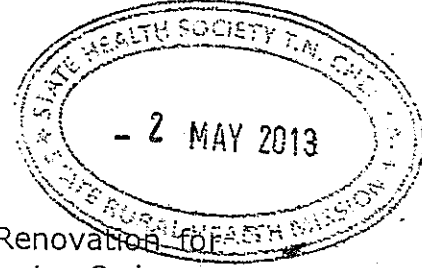

ABSTRACT

State Rural Health Mission – Civil Works – Repairs and Renovation for establishment of NICUs – Sanction of Funds from Government – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Mission Director, State Health Society in his letter read above has stated that the strategy was drawn up in 2008-09, under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) in order to enhance child care services with focused attention for reduction of neonatal deaths. In this strategy, a component is to establish / upgrade the Neonatal Intensive Care Units (NICUs) in the health delivery institutions in the State. The establishment of NICUs / upgradation are being carried out in the State in Phased manner. For the year 2012-13, a proposal for establishment of NICUs / upgradation of existing NICUs in 20 institutions was included in PIP 2012-13, for an aggregate budget cost of Rs.300-lakh. The proposal has been approved by National Project Coordination Committee. In this proposal a sum of Rs.200 lakh was allocated for civil works and electrical works required for NICUs and Rs.100 lakh for other infrastructure.

2) The Mission Director, State Health Society has also stated that a sum of Rs.200 lakh received from Government of India for this work was remitted to Government account vide chalan No.8131, dt.2.11.12 at State Bank of India, Thousand Lights Treasury Branch, Chennai under the head of account "0210-Medical and PH-02-RHS – 800 other receipts – AD receipts from GOI for NRHM works" DP code No.0210-02-800-AD-002 as per G.O.Ms.No.116, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 25.3.11. The proposed repair works and renovation works for the NICUs are given in the Annexure-I to the Government Order.

3) The Mission Director, State Health Society has requested the Government Order on the following:

- i. The Mission Director, State Health Society and The Chief Engineer (Buildings), PWD are permitted to undertake repairs and renovation works for the establishment / upgradation of NICUs in 20 institutions indicated in the Annexure-I to this Government Order at a cost of Rs.200 lakh.
- ii. Sanction is accorded to an amount of Rs.200 lakh (Rupees two hundred lakh only) to Chief Engineer (Buildings), PWD, Chennai towards execution of repair and renovation works in the institutions given in the Annexure-I to this order. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), PWD is authorized to issue orders to the Executive Engineer of PWD Division (Medical Works) in concerned districts to draw the funds of Rs.94.66 lakh for the works indicated in the Annexure-II in this order. He shall authorized the other works in the remaining 14 institutions after getting administrative sanction from the State Health Society. The State Health Society shall accord administrative sanction to the 14 works following rules in force.
- iii. The Mission Director, State Health Society is permitted to change the works and cost of the works on requirement subject to not exceeding the total funds sanctioned in this Government Order.

6) The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"4211-00-Capital outlay on Family Welfare – 103 maternity and child health – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored-SA. National component – Reproductive and Child Health Project-16. Major Works (DPC 4211 00 103 SA 1608).




